

Porto Cristo Mallorca surrounding area Beaches.....



Cala Murada

A beach 110 m long and 70 m wide. It has fine sands and there are some low cliffs limiting it to the right, on top of which some houses have been built. At the back, gather the waters of the torrent des Fangar, where some birds can be seen. It is located in the Cala Murada residential area, between Porto Cristo and Porto Colom.

Services; Restaurants, an open-air bar, lifeguards, showers, hammocks and beach umbrellas for hire.



Es Domingos Petits beach

50 m long and 120 m wide with fine white sands. It is located in the tourist resort of Cales de Mallorca, next to the beach Es Domingos Grans, surrounded by buildings not very high.

Services; Restaurant, an open-air bar, hammocks and beach umbrellas for hire.



Es Domingos Grans beach

The main beach of the tourist resort Cales de Mallorca, very crowded in summer. It is 80 m long and 140 m wide, with fine white sands.

Services; Restaurants, open-air bars, lifeguard, hammocks, beach umbrellas and pedal boats for hire.



Cala Antena

A small beach located in the tourist resort Cales de Mallorca, 30 m long and 70 m wide. The right margin outstands for its verticality while the left one is lower and lacks of tourist buildings.

Services; An open-air bar, hammocks and beach umbrellas for hire.



Cala Bota

A small-unspoilt beach, between high vertical cliffs, 30 m long and 15 m wide with thick pebbles and grave. There is a torrent that pours its waters during rainy seasons.

Services; None



Cala Virgili

An unspoilt small beach, 20 m long and 30 m wide with pebbles and thick grave on the shore and bottoms. On the right there is an escar, a building used by fisherman to keep their boats and fishing tackles.

Services; None



Cala Magraner An unspoilt beach with pebbles and gravel on the shore and bottoms, 60 m long by 65 m wide. There are considerable cliffs, on the east side, on which is a practicable rock climb. At the end of the beach there is a pool of water from a stream.

Services: None

Cala Anguila

Located within the municipality of Manacor. Residential development funded by Swiss capital was started in the early 1970s, and the zone was named **Portocristo Novo**. The area is mainly made up of single-family constructions and tourist apartments.

Services: bars and restaurants; lifeguards; sun loungers, pedal boats and parasols for hire.

Cala Mencia

One of the most recent tourist resorts on **Mallorca** has been developed around this beach. Although development was approved in 1972, it wasn't until the 1990s that this zone was subjected to strong construction and urban growth. There are some hotels but the majority of buildings are single-family constructions and tourist apartments.

Services: bars and restaurants; lifeguards; sun loungers, pedal boats and parasols for hire.

S'Estany den Mas, Cala Romantica

A beach situated by the **Cala Romantica** coastal development within the municipality of Manacor, and mainly comprises detached single-family constructions. It is somewhat larger than the neighbouring developments of **Cala Anguila** and **Cala Mencia**, with which it forms an unbroken line of development along the coast. A lovely white sanded beach perfect for adults with children, also a pick up point for the Boat tours as well as windurfing and sailing lessons are available.

Services: bars and restaurants; lifeguards; sun loungers, pedal boats and parasols for hire.

Porto Cristo beach Majorca

Porto Cristo

Porto Cristo beach Well protected from the wind and seaborne storms. The situation of the **Porto Cristo** beach means that it is an ideal spot for swimming right from the start of summer, or even during winter for the more adventurous. At the height of summer, the high throughput of pleasure craft in the port means that the quality of the water is not as high as at other points on the island, even so, there are always plenty of swimmers in the water.

During the winter it makes for excellent Beach fishing as the lights from the promenade illuminate the area.

Services: bars and restaurants; lifeguards; sun loungers, pedal boats and parasols for hire.

S'illot beach

Also known

as **Cala Moreia**, is 350m long and 35m wide; it is very popular during the summer months. At the right-hand end of the beach there is a small platform which is used as a landing dock, whilst at the other end of the beach there is a small pool where the torrent of N Amer flows out to sea.

Services: bars and restaurants; lifeguards; sun loungers, pedal boats and parasols for hire.
